



Dear Parents,

The New Kids Team is looking forward to hosting your New Kid this Sunday! Please read this entire email so you know what to expect.

We are so excited to nurture the love of Jesus in all of our New Kids so that we can see the great things God is going to do in their lives! Your New Kid will be engaging in a curriculum that will reinforce that God made them, God loves them, and that Jesus wants to be their friend forever. Our focus is to be intentional with this message by not only teaching this to our New Kids each Sunday but also equipping our parents to encourage these messages throughout the week. We can't wait to get started!

As we prepare to bring our New Kids together in the coming weeks, we want you to know what precautions we are taking to keep our New Kids safe.

We are prepared to implement the following guidelines:

1. We will temperature check each child utilizing a no-touch forehead thermometer before entering the New Kid classroom.
2. We have purchased hand sanitizers and sanitizing wipes safe for little hands, for use when needed.
3. We have developed a schedule for increased cleaning of our area and the supplies used by children.
4. We will keep our New Kids in-person groups small (10 or less people in the nursery and Preschool environments and 25 Elementary kids that will be well spaced out in their theater).

Here is what you can do to help us maintain these guidelines:

1. Please refrain from entering the New Kids areas. The fewer the people in this space, the easier it is for us to keep it clean and safe.
2. Please do not send drinks or snacks unless your child has allergies. We will provide individually wrapped drinks and snacks for your child.
3. New Kids from ages 3-10 are encouraged to wear facial coverings.

While we have made many plans to keep our students socially distanced, we also understand that kids need to and will move, but you have our pledge that we will do our best to keep our New Kids active, engaged, and learning in a socially distanced manner.

Thank you for helping us put these precautions in place, so that we may come together as a church family. We can't wait to see you on Sunday!
