

We Kick off each Small Group Semester (September, January, June) with a Small Group Fair. While the online Group directory is the primary venues New Co. provides for its members to connect to groups and group leaders, this one is a very effective way to do the same. During this time, you'll have an opportunity to share about your group, collect sign ups, and connect with other group leaders and coaches.

- 1. Arrive Sunday Morning any time between 9:00-9:30AM to set up your “booth” for your Small Group.**
You will find your group name on one of the tables along with name tags for anyone who plans to help you host your booth, and a QR Code sheet.
- 2. Be considerate of our COVID-19 precautions.** We will ensure the tables and groups are adequately spaced out, with leaders on one side of the table and members on the other side. We will have gloves, masks, and face shields available to help facilitate safe, spacious mingling.
- 3. Be creative in how you communicate about your group.**
Your booth will be approximately 2.5 ft x 2.5 ft. Use pictures, flyers, study materials, photos, flyer, a unique snack, etc. that draws people to pay attention to your table and stop by for a visit.
- 4. Let people know they can ‘preview’ your group.** If they’ll agree to come just one time, chances are greater than 50% they’ll keep coming to your small group. If he/she can’t make the first meeting, encourage him/her to come to the 2nd or 3rd meeting.
- 5. Help people sign up for your group with your phone.** The BEST way to get someone signed up for your group is to have your Roster pulled up on your phone and add people who express interest!
- 6. Be a champion of all our small groups.** When anyone signs up for a group, whether yours or another, let them know you’re glad they found their group!
